MATHEMATICS	3 Years
SCIENCE	2 Years 1 Year in a Biological & 1 Year in a Physical At least one science must meet UC “d” requirement
VISUAL & PERFORMING ARTS	1 Year
WORLD LANGUAGE	1 year by the end of 10th grade
HEALTH	1 semester – completed in 9th grade
PHYSICAL EDUCATION	2 years – completed in 9th & 10th grades
ELECTIVES	50 credits to meet the credit requirement
