



San Mateo High School After School Activity Bus to Foster City

The After School Activity (ASA) bus is available to transport students who stay after school to participate in the sports programs and other extracurricular activities. ASA buses operate four days a week during athletic seasons and will depart from the bus stop on Poplar Ave. at San Mateo High School at 6:05pm. Students can use the bus by purchasing a pass. There will be no ASA bus on Fridays or minimum days.

ASA Bus passes may be purchased at the San Mateo High School accounting office between 8:00am to 4:00pm October 25 through November 9th. The applications are on the District web page. After November 13th, ASA Bus Passes can be purchased at 839 Hinckley Ave. Burlingame, CA. Two types of ASA Bus Passes are available:

- Fall ASA Bus Pass (Oct 30 – Dec 19, 2017)
- Spring ASA Bus Pass (Jan 9 – May 24, 2018)

If your student already rides the bus and has purchased one of the following passes:

- Annual Round Trip Pass
- Annual One Way PM Pass
- Monthly Pass

their bus pass will be honored and they will not be obligated to purchase another pass.

If you qualify for free and reduced benefits, please bring your paperwork with you when purchasing the pass.

Activity bus routes run limited stops. Your student may or may not be dropped off at their normal pick-up or drop-off site. Students should choose the bus stop that is nearest their home. The schedule is as follows:
